

## **Mapleton Forest Trails Track 2**

### **Amendments**

- 1.** Track 2 (T.2) starts on the opposite side of the road from the car park. Enter the trail through a wooden stile next to a metal barrier. This will take you along a wide track, this is sign posted T.2.
- 2.** After a short distance you'll see a small quarry on the right, keep going straight ahead
- 3.** After about 15 or 20 minutes walking you come to an intersection where you follow the track left at the T.2 sign.
- 4.** After a short distance you will come to another junction where you follow the track to the left marked with the T2 sign.
- 5.** Continue straight ahead through a clearing and under power lines. Re-enter the forest and take the next turn left.
- 6.** This takes you past a small creek and back to the clearing and under power lines. Re-enter the forest, ignoring the narrow turn off to the right just before next T.2 sign opposite an impressive stand of large Xanthorrhoea on your left.
- 7.** This will take you back to a metal barrier, cross through and immediately turn left, following the T.2 sign. Walk directly across the dirt road picking up the narrow track on the other side.
- 8.** After about 5 metres and at the next T intersection turn left. Follow the undulating trail which runs parallel to the road past tall Tree Ferns, native vegetation and stands of tall timbers.
- 9.** After about 30 minutes and briefly after you see 2 green markers at each side of the track you'll see a brown roofed wooden toilet structure ahead. Take the first unmarked narrow trail left, which will lead you the Mapleton Day Use Area, with picnic and barbeque facilities. From here you will be able to spot your car parked across the road.
