

# ELANDA TO HARRY'S HUT ROAD

Cooloola Section Great Sandy National Park

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1. The track starts opposite the car park. It is well signposted. The walk passes through a paperbark forest on a mowed grassy path.
2. After a short distance the track crosses a wide, well mowed path with powerlines and then another, keep straight ahead. After a short distance the track merges with another one coming in from the right, keep left. This brings you to a T intersection with an interpretive sign, turn right. It is a good idea to remember this turn as it is not well signed on the way back.
3. Continue on through open grassland with lots of wallabies and native birds. After a while, at what looks like the end of the trail, the track veers left. Continue left through the metal gate. There is a large sign detailing the many walks in the area.
4. Follow the track until you reach the next intersection which is marked Mill Point (700 metres ) and Elanda Point straight ahead (700 metres ).
5. Turn left and continue on straight ahead on the wide grassy track through lightly timbered grass land. At the next intersection turn left onto the Kin Kin Creek walk.
